The papers will be sent only through the SGE application that can be found in the web page of the conference ([www.saaei.org](http://www.saaei.org)) and they should be saved as pdf. In the application, the following should be included:

Title.

- Authors.
- Topic area.
- Presentation preference.
- A summary less than 3000 characters long.
